Transportation Services to Regional Multicultural Magnet School School Year 2017-2018

Transportation to the Regional Multicultural Magnet School is provided and funded by each sending town. Below are the transportation arrangements provided for the 2017-2018 school year. Districts reexamine transportation arrangements each year. This does not guarantee transportation for the 2018-2019 school year.

Transportation Reimbursement – A small stipend may be available from the State of Connecticut to parents who transport their children to and from RMMS from communities where transportation is *not* available. A form to apply for reimbursement is available in the summer at the RMMS Office. The form is due to RMMS by the middle of September.

East Lyme – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at their homes or at a near-by bus stop.

East Haddam – Currently no transportation is provided.

Groton – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at a bus stop within walking distance to their homes.

Navy Youth Center Van – A dedicated van is provided to and from RMMS for students currently enrolled in their program.

Montville – Transportation is provided. Three buses pick up students and drop them off at bus stops close to their homes. The three buses meet at the Montville town hall and transfer all students to one bus that brings the students to/from RMMS.

New London – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at a bus stop within walking distance to their homes.

North Stonington – Transportation is provided. Students meet at the commuter parking lot off exit 92.

Norwich – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at two transportation centers in town: *Walmart* Parking Lot and the *Norwich Bowling and Entertainment Center* across from the commuter parking lot.

Towns located on the 395 Corridor – Transportation is provided from the two Norwich transportation centers: *Walmart* Parking Lot and the *Norwich Bowling and Entertainment Center* across from the commuter parking lot. Towns currently included are:

Old Lyme - Transportation is not currently available, but may be available upon request from the Salem Board of Education. In the past, transportation has been contracted with East Lyme transportation and students could be dropped off at East Lyme High School.

Preston – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at their homes or at a bus stop within walking distance to their homes.

Salem – Transportation is not currently available, but may be available upon request from the Salem Board of Education. In the past, transportation has been contracted with East Lyme transportation and students could be dropped off at East Lyme High School.

Stonington – Transportation is provided. Students are picked up/dropped off at their homes or at a bus stop within walking distance to their homes.

Waterford – Transportation is provided. In the morning, students are picked up at a bus stop within walking distance to their home by their neighborhood school bus. Students are transported to their neighborhood school. One bus from each Waterford neighborhood school transports children to RMMS. In the afternoon, two Waterford buses return students to their homes.
